

## **Announcement of changes to the recording of HPB Surgery procedures in the eLogbook**

Dear eLogbook users

Following on from the wide-ranging changes to other aspects of General Surgery in the eLogbook recently, a similar process has been completed in regard to HPB Surgery by consulting with specialty surgical and training organisations. It was clear that modern practice has meant changes in procedures being performed and the new terminology is reflected in the changes that will be made in the eLogbook.

The table below lists the procedures that have historically been listed on the left with the new list of descriptors on the right. Those highlighted in **green** will be recognised on the ISCP as a Major UGI case, relevant for CCT. Operations which have been logged under the historic terms will not be lost. Some will automatically change to the new description, for others you may choose to change the descriptors of operations that have previously been logged to the new ones if appropriate. Once a change has been made, if the old description is no longer available then you cannot change it back.

Although in the UK most endoscopy procedures are logged on the JETS platform, we have also included some changes to the eLogbook in relation to endoscopic procedures (these will be in the Procedures rather than Operations section) - seen in **blue**.

As there has been some discussion recently around what constitutes an operation performed (rather than assisted) in larger cases, some operation parts will be available (seen in **purple**) for some of the major resectional procedures. This should allow more accurate documentation which will allow trainers and TPDs to understand how much of an operation has been performed. The introduction of these specific changes may warrant a review by users of the eLogbook of previously logged operations? We are also looking at doing this in other areas, such as renal transplant in the near future.

The changes will be implemented over the weekend of 24 January 2026.

I do get requests for additional procedures to be added on a regular basis. These are welcome and I try to be reactive to these, so new procedures will be added over time.

My thanks go out to those who have contributed to this discussion and helped me understand the complexities of modern HPB surgery to create the new list of operations, in particular Irena Stefanova, Emily Britton and Ravi Marudanayagam.
